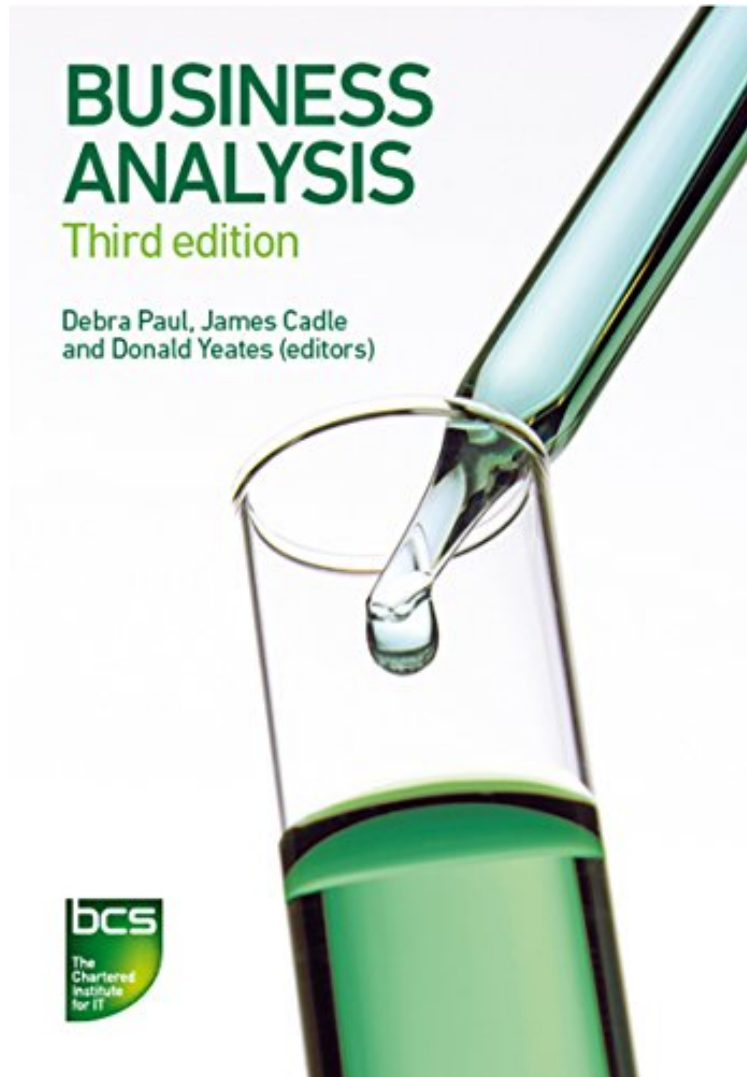

I bought this book to prepare for the BCS Business Analysis Foundation exam, to fill gaps in my knowledge. I read the book twice over a period of time (months, though with a gap in between). The book is fairly easy to read, though I didn't find it captivating. There are places I felt could have done with lists or bullet points, rather than continuous prose. There were a few typos and editing errors. As

for the material itself, I think it was good enough, though the section about system development lifecycles and approaches did not clearly distinguish between lifecycles and approaches, though the text effectively said that they are distinct. I sat the exam today and passed. I think I scored well over 80%. (Waiting for official results - Update: I got 37/40).
