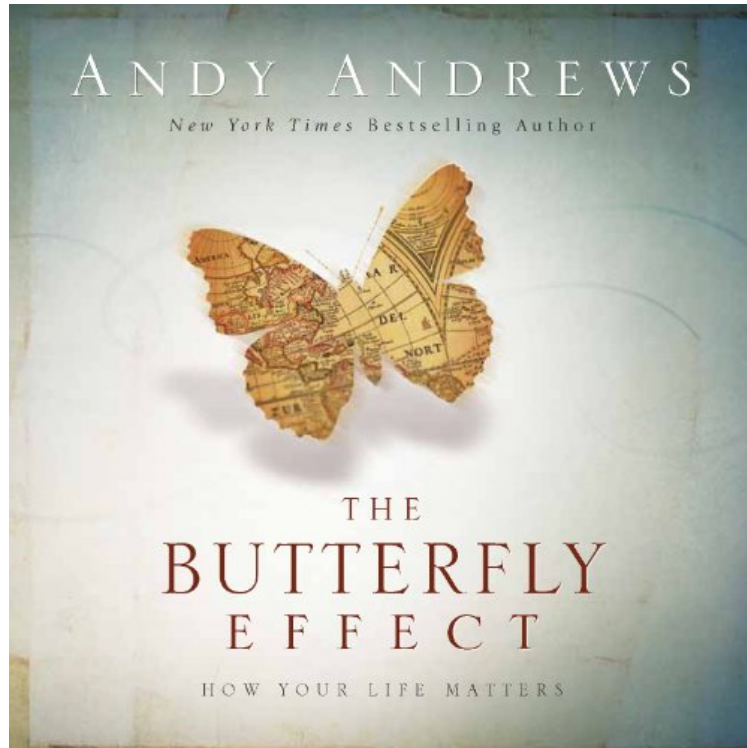


Butterfly Effect: How Your Life Matters
