If only there were an alternative econ career book...By Craig MileThe "Great Jobs..." series (offerings range from accounting to theatre) all suffer from a rather fundamental flaw: None of their authors posses the skills of which they're purporting to be qualified to give advice on. Camenson knows nothing about economics. If someone is writing career books for a living, chances are that they are among the worst people to be getting career advice from (unless you want to write career books). What's worse, the vast bulk of this book does not even pertain to economics. Instead it offers examples of sloppy cover letters and "methods of self assessment" that have been simply rehashed from the other books of this series. In essence, there is only one book in the "Great Jobs..." series; it has just been fitted with a different cover for each undergraduate major in hopes to appeal to the broadest audience. Great idea - Bad book.
