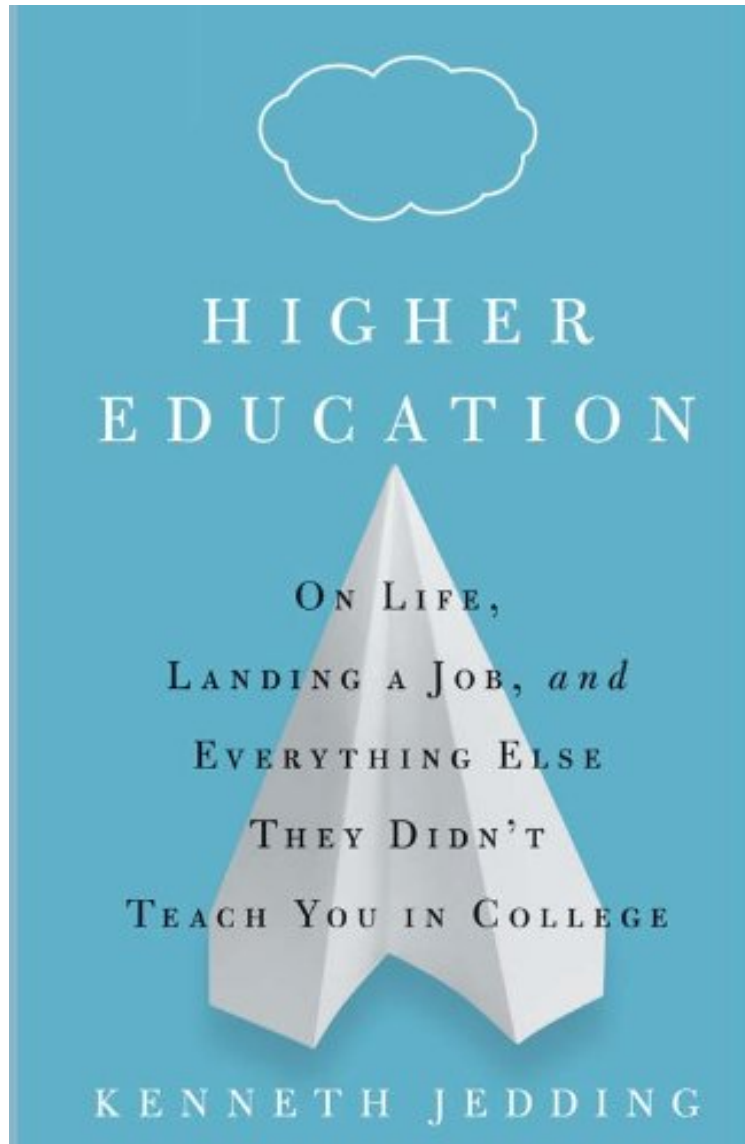

It is also filled with hubris and simply incorrect assertions regarding higher education for students and families across the spectrum of class in private vs. public universities. Opinions are freely offered but not firmly anchored in ANY empirical research. A simple bar chart from IPEDS data would show that colleges and universities are investing so much more in counseling and support than they ever have. It is unconscionable that bloated affirmations of self substitute for the many thoughtful texts that abound in this field. Do not waste your money, or your time, as Mr. Jedding did, in writing this personal diary for public consumption.
