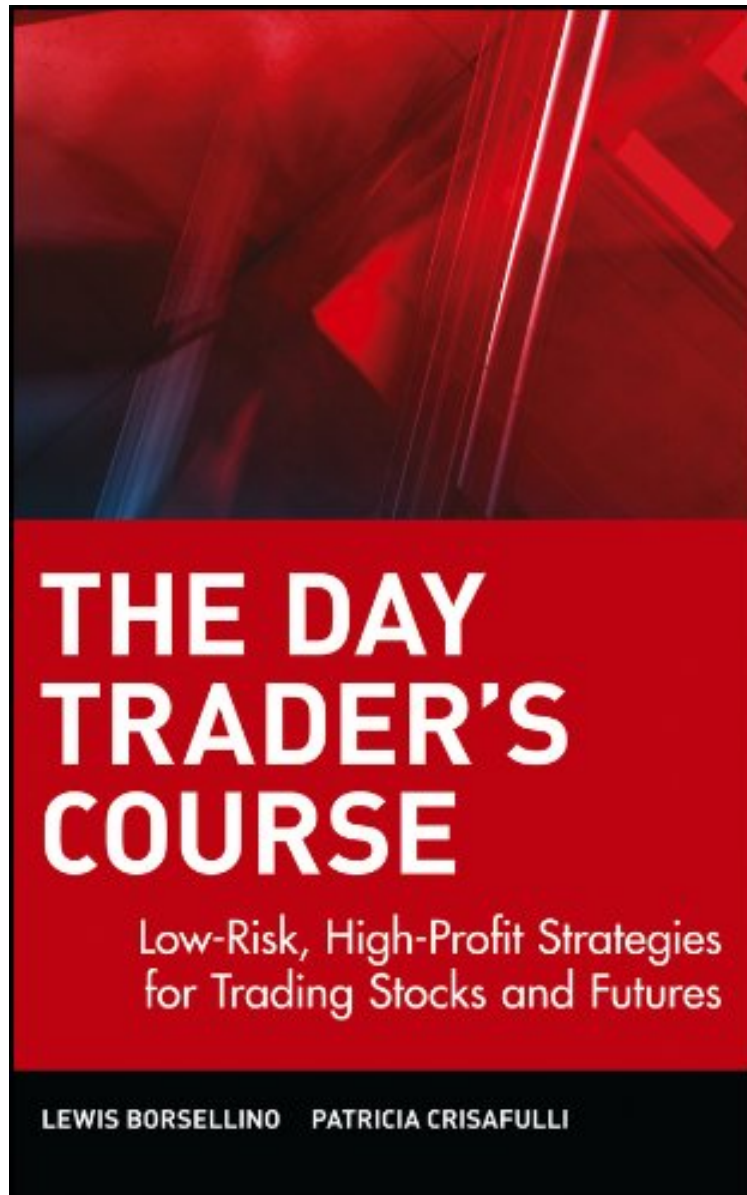

My trading library is quite extensive at this point and this work by Mr Borsellino gets my highest rating. He presents his area of expertise in trading for what it really is, no fluff. His portrayal of "Stepping Through the Trades" and "IntraDay Dynamics" would be useful to anyone at any stage of trading since he honestly shows how a trade setup that is evaluated and entered properly can be a winner - loser - or prematurely closed.
